Thank you so much to all the children and parents who participated in the 20 Days of Wellbeing Challenge. It has been great to see so many of the children taking part in the activities.



Year 5 learning:

Week beginning: Monday 2nd February 2026

Maths	In Maths, the children will continue their learning of fractions. They will be multiplying unit and non-unit fractions, multiply mixed numbers and add and subtract fractions with the same denominators.
Writing	Last week, the children innovated their model text. This week, we will be focusing on the grammar and writing features that the children found the most challenging. This includes, relative clauses, modal verbs, parenthesis and up-levelling their sentences. Then, they will be using all they have learnt to invent their own set of instructions.
Integrated curriculum	Now the children have finished their research, they will be collaborating to present their findings on a natural disaster.
Science	As the children continue their learning of forces, they will be preparing and conducting an experiment that involved friction. Then, they will be using everything they have learnt about forces to complete their hot task.
