Dear Parents,

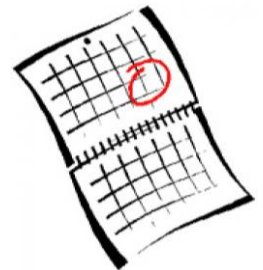
Thank you so much to all the children and parents who participated in the 20 Days of Wellbeing Challenge. It has been great to see so many of the children taking part in the activities.

	Writing	For writing this week, children will be working collaboratively to identify ways to improve writing with a particular focus on descriptive vocabulary.
	IC	This week in IC, we will begin assembling our cars. Students will be guided step-by-step through the process to ensure they understand how each part fits together.
	Science	This week in Science we will be exploring how light reflects off different surfaces. Students will be designing a maze and creating it to support light reflection.
