FS2 learning:

Week beginning: Monday 16th February 2026

This week in Phonics, we will learn about the new diagraphs from Phase 3 of Monster Phonics: 'oo', and 'ow, linking with the story of Little Red Riding Hood'.

In Communication and Language, we will continue to develop and extend our expressive communication by incorporating Makaton Signs into our daily routines and in our play. The Sign of the Week is "Ramadan Kareem," we will also learn 'to give' in English, Arabic and in Makaton.

In Personal, Social and Emotional Development, we will talk about resilience.

This week in our Understanding the World lessons, we are going to learn about the past and the present, events that happened and people that did great things long ago and now. Our school is divided into different houses according to colours and those houses represent people who has done important things in history. These houses are Armstrong, Thesiger, Stinnes and Costeau. History is a big word for important events that happened long ago that changed the way we think about the world.

This week in Literacy, we are enjoying the story Whatever Next! The children will draw Baby Bear and his rocket journey and write a simple sentences. We will also be learning and using new vocabulary linked to the story. We will create rockets in EAD .

This week in Maths, we will be exploring how to select, rotate, and manipulate shapes. Through hands-on activities, we will build, move, and turn different shapes to help develop our spatial reasoning skills. We will be talking about what we see, how shapes fit together, and how we can change shapes to create new designs.
