Year 1 learning:

Week beginning: Monday 16th February 2026

This week, we will begin our topic about 'Food Glorious Food' and during our science lessons we will learn the different parts of a plant. We will learn the importance of each part and the role it plays in helping the plant to grow and thrive.

In maths, we will begin our multiplication and division topic. We will start the week counting in 10s using our previous knowledge to aid our work. We will then count in 2s starting with grouping objects, counting and then relating this learning to our multiplications.

In our English lessons we will complete an introduction to instructions. We will learn what instructions are and how they help us to complete tasks. We will practically follow some given instructions and begin to understand the importance of following instructions in the correct order. We will then look at the features of instructions such as title, what you will need and numbered instructions that are in order.

In phonics, we will learn the sounds 'ear' as in year, 'ear' making the air sound as in wear and 'are' making the air sound as in care. We will be learning to identify, read and write words using these sounds, as well as challenging ourselves to write simple sentences.
