Year 2 Learning:

Week beginning: Monday 16th February 2026

Maths	In maths, we will begin our new <i>Multiplication and Division</i> topic. We will start the week by assessing the children's prior knowledge of this unit. Next, the children will learn to recognise equal and unequal groups before understanding how to make equal groups of their own.
English	In English, the children will begin to plan and write their own version of the <i>Jack and the Beanstalk</i> story, starting with the opening section. We will continue to focus on encouraging the children to say their sentence aloud, write it and then read over it to check that it makes sense. Within their writing, they will be expected to include capital letters, full stops, adjectives and some exclamation marks. We will also encourage the children to work in groups to edit and improve their work together.
Science and Integrated Curriculum	In science, we will start our new science-based topic entitled <i>Material World</i> . The children will begin by identifying the uses of everyday materials by going on a 'material hunt' around the school. They will then identify the suitability of everyday materials before being set a special challenge. The results from the challenge will enable them to understand the importance of using materials that are fit for purpose.

Wellbeing Wednesday

Our Wellbeing Committee is pleased to introduce **Wellbeing Wednesday's**, an initiative for Term 2 focused on building kindness and care across our school community.

Each Wednesday, a short wellbeing prompt will be shared with staff and students, encouraging one small action and a brief reflection on why it matters. These moments are designed to remind us that small intentional actions can make a meaningful difference.

Resilience

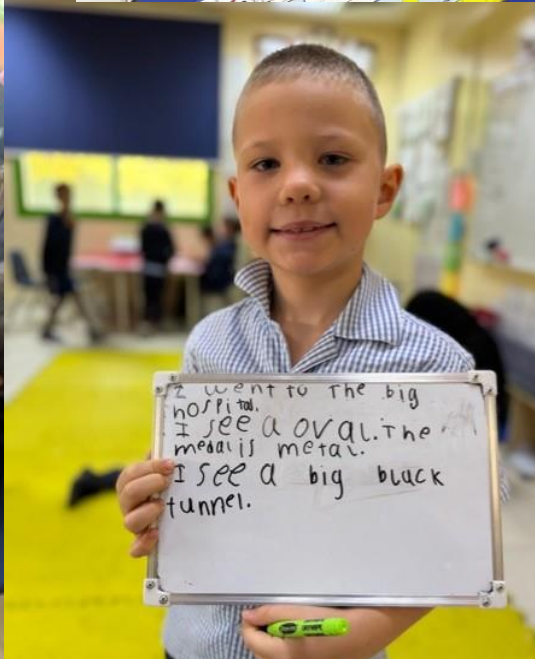
