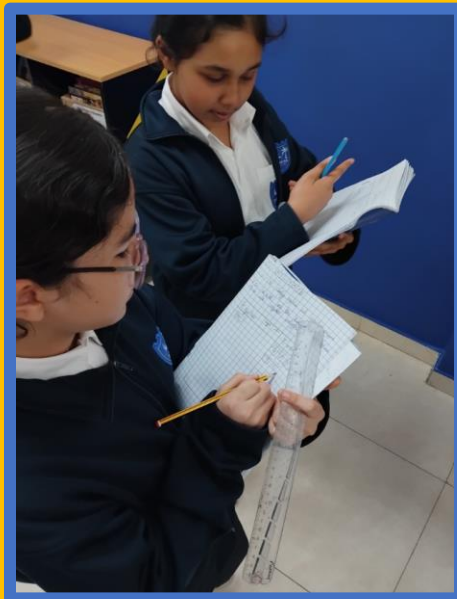
Our expectations are that students will:
