Year 4 learning:

Week beginning: Monday 23rd February 2026

English	In English, the children shall be continuing their learning of poems and their exploration of their model text. They will be beginning to plan their own poem based around the model text, including collecting sounds of their own to create an original poem based around 'The Sound Collector'.
Maths	In maths, the children will be continuing their learning by exploring the areas of shapes. They will be finding the areas of rectilinear shapes and comparing these areas also. In addition to this, they will be using this knowledge and applying it to problem solving questions.
Science	As we continue to explore our states of matter topic, we will be learning how the particles in the different states of matter behave and what happens to these particles as we change from one state to the other. To help with this understanding, we will be investigating the best way to melt ice and discussing how heat effects the particles in the ice leading it to melt.
Topic	In Topic, Year 4 will be developing their learning of the Victorian era. They will be delving deeper into the day-to-day life and the industrial revolution. They will be exploring the different inventions of the Victorian era and how this changed and improved life for them.
