Year 5 learning:

Week beginning: Monday 23rd February 2026

Maths	In maths, the children will be finding equivalent fractions and decimals. This means learning to convert fractions to decimals and decimals to fractions. They will then be doing problem solving questions involving this before completing revision for their hot task, which will be the following Monday.
Writing	In writing, the children will be learning about what a suspense story is and the writing features included in this genre. They will be learning how to use punctuation for affect, use relative clauses. Then, they will watch a short clip to inspire a short suspense piece of writing.
Integrated curriculum	As we continue our 'Mission to Mars' topic, the children will be learning all about the UAE's current mission in space and Mars.



Our expectations are that students will:
