Year 4 learning:

Week beginning: Monday 2nd March 2026

English	In English, Year 4 will be writing their own poems based around the sounds previously collected and their understanding of the model text. Following this, they will edit and improve their poems before publishing them!
Maths	In maths, Year 4 will be first exploring unit-fractions as decimals, such as $\frac{1}{2} = 0.5$ and $\frac{1}{4} = 0.25$, etc. After this, they will be learning how to convert between millimeters, centimeters, and meters. They will then cement their understanding using problem solving style questions.
Science	This week in science, year 4 will be exploring evaporation and condensation by completing an experiment allowing them to observe ice being melted to water, then evaporating into water vapor, before hitting a cold surface turning the vapor back into water droplets. This will help the children understand the water cycle further through a practical way.
Topic	In topic, Year 4 will be researching different laws that were passed during the Victorian Era and discussing how they improved the lives of the people living in the British Empire. We will then use this information to create a factual poster about each law and how they helped to improve Britain.
