Year 5 learning:

Week beginning: Monday 2nd March 2026

Maths	At the start of this week, the children will have their Maths hot task. It will include the learning we have done so far since January. Once they have done their hot task, they will be starting their new learning of converting between units of measure. They will convert mm to cm, cm to m and g to kg.
Writing	The children will be learning how to use expanded noun phrases to create suspense in a piece of writing. Then, they will be writing a setting description. After that, they will be looking at how they can use speech to create suspense.
Integrated curriculum	As we continue our learning of space, the children will learn about the history of space exploration. Then, they will be comparing the environments of other planets to earth.
Science	In science, the children will be learning the different theories of planetary orbit and what causes night and day. At the end of this week, the children will then have their science hot task which will be about earth and space.


