Important Information:

- For the next 2 weeks we will complete our learning online and at Al Ain English Speaking School (AAESS) this combines several complementary approaches to ensure learning remains structured, engaging and flexible.
- Learning will follow the normal school timetable, where possible, to maintain routine.
- Children will engage with live lessons which will be delivered by the teacher, recorded teacher inputs, and independent learning tasks which can be completed at a time convenient to your child.
- Offline tasks and movement breaks will be built into learning to support wellbeing and allow time away from the screen.

Year 2 learning:

Week beginning: Monday 23rd March 2026

Maths	In Maths, we will continue with our <i>Multiplication and Division</i> unit of work. The children will begin the week by focusing on doubling and halving numbers. This will help to consolidate their learning on multiplying and dividing by 2 from previous lessons. Following this, we will be exploring the concept of odd and even numbers. Finally, we will take a closer look at the 10 times table, as the children use their knowledge of multiplication to count forwards and backwards in tens.
English	For the next few weeks, we will be focusing on the <i>Talk for Writing</i> wishing tale <i>Alfie's Star</i> by Sue Cove. We will begin the week by sharing the story with the children before getting them to discuss and express their views on the story. Following this, the children will be encouraged to ask and answer different questions about the text. Finally, we will focus on different vocabulary from the story, as we learn the definitions of the keywords and try to use the new vocabulary within sentences.
