Important Information:

- For the next 2 weeks we will complete our learning online and at Al Ain English Speaking School (AAESS) this combines several complementary approaches to ensure learning remains structured, engaging and flexible.
- Learning will follow the normal school timetable, where possible, to maintain routine.
- Children will engage with live lessons which will be delivered by the teacher, recorded teacher inputs, and independent learning tasks which can be completed at a time convenient to your child.
- Offline tasks and movement breaks will be built into learning to support wellbeing and allow time away from the screen.

Year 4 learning:

Week beginning: Monday 23rd March 2026

English	In English, Year 4 will be finishing off our unit of work on poetry by writing and performing our own poems. This will allow the children to develop their performance skills through dramatic voices, varied pacing, and engaging gestures.
Maths	In Maths, Year 4 will be revisiting previous learning to consolidate their understanding. The children will be examining data and interpreting information from this. They will also be developing their learning of division by using the formal short method to divide 2-digit numbers by a 1-digit number.
Science	In Science, Year 4 will be developing their understanding around the water cycle. Further to this, they will be looking at the scientific names for each stage and the processes which take place.
Topic	This week, Year 4 will be collecting information about different laws in the Victorian era and how the change they brought impacted people's lives. Also, they will then create a poster to display the information collected in a creative way.
