Important Information:

- For the next week we will complete our learning online and at Al Ain English Speaking School (AAESS) this combines several complementary approaches to ensure learning remains structured, engaging and flexible.

| English | We will begin studying our new text, <i>The Iron Man</i> by Ted Hughes. The children will describe the Iron Man and develop their understanding of fronted adverbials, as well as time and cause conjunctions. |
| Maths | In maths, we are beginning our unit on mass and capacity. The children will be learning how to read and use scales, measure in grams and kg, to know how to measure equivalent masses (kg, g) and to compare mass. |
| Science | In science we will begin our topic on 'Light' firstly reflecting our big question 'Why do we need light to see things?' Then the children will begin to explore various sources of light. |
| Topic | We will begin our new topic called Lighting up the world. The children will be learning about the history of the lightbulb and who invented it. In art, the children will be working in the style of Piet Mondrian using primary colours. The topic and art lessons can be found on Teams, in the classwork folder. |
