Important Information:

- For the next week we will complete our learning online and at Al Ain English Speaking School (AAESS) this combines several complementary approaches to ensure learning remains structured, engaging and flexible.

| Maths | In maths, we will be working on converting different units of measure. Lessons include, converting centimetres to metres, a practical lesson where we will make paper planes and measure distance, multiplying and dividing by 1000 and converting grams to kilograms. |
| Writing | During writing lessons, we will begin to explore the wide-ranging topic of poetry. Children will begin by looking at the varied structure and purposes of poems. |
| Integrated curriculum | Next week, children will move onto a new topic on "Far East". They will learn what Far East means and where it is on the map, compared to the middle east. They will look at different countries in this region and explore how the cultures there are similar or different. |
| Science | We will be starting a new topic this week of animals including humans. To start, the children will be learning about important stages of their life and creating a timeline/poster to show this. Then, with Ms Taylor, they will be learning about the human life cycle. |
