## Year 3 learning:

**Week beginning: Monday 13th April 2026**

English	We will be continuing to innovate the Iron Man story, planning and writing up paragraph 3 and 4
Maths	We will review multiplication and division by practicing how to multiply a one-digit number by a two-digit number using the 3 and 4 times tables. We will also solve problems that involve both multiplication and division. In addition, we will learn how to divide a two-digit number by a one-digit number and explore flexible partitioning strategies.
Science	We will be planning and undertaking a practical investigation to see which surfaces reflect light.
Topic	To learn about the Northern lights and create a piece of artwork on the northern lights.
