English	This week we will begin by finishing our Iron Man story. Then we will be inventing a new story using everything we learnt during the innovation stage.
Maths	To continue our topic on multiplication and division, we will be multiplying 1 digit by 2 digit numbers for the 3 and 4 times table. The children will learn how to use flexible partitioning to divide a 2 digit number by a 1 digit number.
Science	This week we will investigate how shadows change through practical exploration. Then we will learn how light travels to our eyes.
Topic	To complete the Northern Lights quiz. To learn about Vincent Van Gogh and recreate A starry night.
