Important Information:

FS2 Learning:

Week beginning: Monday 30th March 2026

The children have settled back into school life so well and have shown so much resilience. We will continue to support them to persevere in the face of a challenge.

In communication and language, we will continue to develop conversations and vocabulary and introduce new sings and symbols related to our 'under the sea' theme.

With physical development, we will continue to build the foundations of a handwriting style that is fast and accurate.

This week in phonics, we will be recapping all the sounds learned to date and identifying any sounds that require further revision. The children will practise recognising this sounds in words, read simple words and sentences and all the sounds and tricky words in their writing.

This week in literacy we will continue to develop children's understanding of non-fiction and use new vocabulary to talk, draw and write simple sentences about sea creatures.

This week, we will continue practising subitising and recalling number bonds to 5 independently, as well as exploring number bonds to 10 further, using our fingers or concrete objects. We will also reinforce our understanding of doubles. Can you use items from around your home to show different ways to make 5 and/or 10? Perhaps you could also find objects to represent doubles.

This week in EAD, we will continue to create stories with our friends and teachers. We will use sustainable materials to make a theatre set and we will then use our sea creature stick puppets to retell our part of the Way Down Deep story.

This week in UTW, we will continue learning about pearl diving and boats from the past and the present. Use the pre-recorded video to go through the PowerPoint Presentation and learn about different boats and pearl diving. Can you use the boat template provided to create your own boat? What makes your boat the same or different compared to a Dhow boat? If you were a pearl diver, what would you use to collect the pearls from the bottom of the sea?
