Week beginning: Monday 27th April 2026

Maths	In maths, we will continue with our work on angles. Lessons include- drawing lines and angles, calculating angles on a straight line and calculating angles around a point. We will complete the week with mental maths.
Writing	During writing next week, we will be planning, writing, and performing our own poems, incorporating the poetry features we have learned about over the past few weeks.
Integrated curriculum	In topic, children will be using their research from last few weeks and creating a fact file based on their chosen far eastern country. They will also learn about Terracotta Warriors in China.
Science	In science next week, the children are going to be using their data from this week's investigations to present their data accurately. They will identify patterns and explain reasons for this.
