Year 2 learning:

Week beginning: Monday 4th May 2026

Maths	This week in maths, we will continue with the unit <i>Mass, Capacity and Temperature</i> . The children will start the week by learning to measure in kilograms (kg). They will be given the experience of picking up and feeling kilogram weights and thinking about comparing these to everyday objects for context. Following this, the children will focus on using and applying their multiplication and division skills to solve one-step (and multi-step) word problems involving different weight measurements. They will then move on to compare volume and capacity, ensuring that they understand the difference between the meaning of the two words and can apply their knowledge within a real-life context. To conclude the week, the children will be taking a practical approach to estimating and measuring liquid in millilitres and litres in the form of a water challenge.
English	In English, we will continue with our <i>Instructions</i> unit of work. The children will start to plan and write their own set of instructions for how to make a delicious smoothie of their choosing. They will start by planning and writing their own heading, introduction and ingredients/equipment list. We will conclude the week by planning and writing the method part of our instruction text, remembering to include numbered points, imperative verbs and adverbs.
Science	In science, the children will continue to learn about how to be healthy. This week, we will continue to investigate the importance of healthy eating by comparing and rating different lunch boxes and understanding the positive effects of having a healthy and balanced diet.
Integrated Curriculum	In topic, the children will use different media (paint, crayons, oil pastels, etc) to complete their Anna Tokarska and Giuseppe Arcimboldo inspired fruit and vegetable self-portraits.
