| English | The children have been working incredibly hard learning all the features of a narrative. Next week, the children will use all of their learning to create their own narrative story based on an adventure. They will create their own setting and coming up with characters to create their own adventure.           |
| Maths   | The children will be finishing off their work on shaped and moving on to learning about plotting and position of coordinates. We will start to learn about UK money learning the different values of the coins and notes. The children will then learn to solve problems utilising the skills they have just learnt. |
| Science | The children will be continuing to build on their circuit building skills. The children will be learning how to make a push button switch in their circuit. Following this, they will be consolidating their learning with the class teacher.  |
