Year 3 learning:

Week beginning: Monday 18th May 2026

English	We will continue to write up our own version of The Egyptian Cinderella, planning and writing paragraphs 3 and 4 and using our success criteria to help us.
Maths	The children will learn to recognise angles as a property of shape and be able to identify right angles and recognise that two right angles make a half turn. They will also learn to identify angles less than and greater than a right angle and to draw and measure accurately (cm and mm).
Science	During our forces topic the children will learn what friction is and will undertake an investigation exploring friction on different surfaces.
Topic	This week the children will learn about the 7 wonders of the world. In art, the children will be designing and beginning to make an Egyptian necklace.
