**Week beginning: Monday, 18th May 2026**

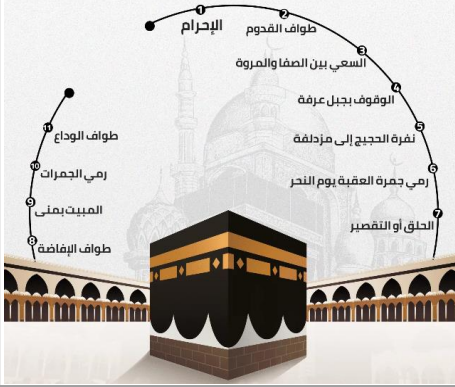

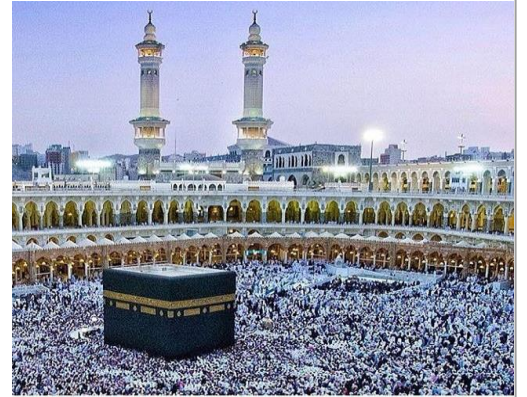
Dear students, As-salamu Alaikum.
