FS2 Learning:

Week beginning: Monday 1st June 2026

This week in Maths, we will be recapping what we have learned about numbers and numerical patterns.

In Understanding the World, we will be recapping the States of Matter and looking at Solids, Liquids and Gases. We will be comparing the three different states of matter and look at the similarities and differences

This week in Literacy we will be creating invitations and tickets for our end of year performance. The children will explore the features of invitations and tickets to write key information and design their work creatively in preparation for our special event.

In EAD we will be creating a bottle fish from recyclable material in preparation for World Ocean's Day next week.

This week in Phonics, we will continue revising previously taught sounds while focusing on teaching and practicing the reading and spelling of words having previously learned digraphs. Children will also practice recognising and recalling taught graphemes, alongside reading, and writing simple sentences independently.

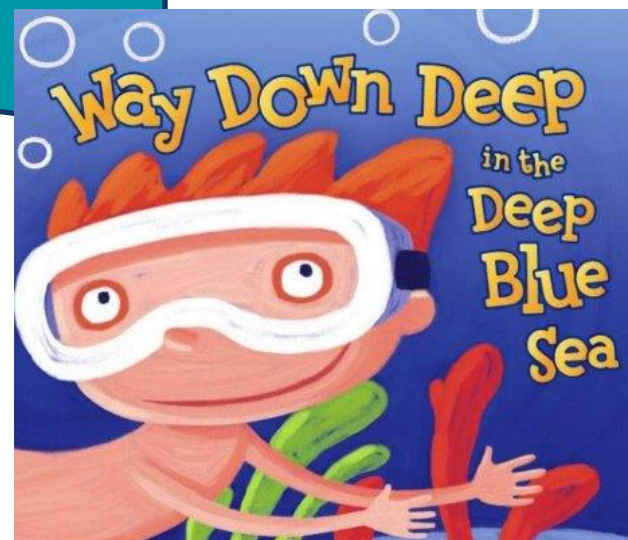
