Year 3 learning:

Week beginning: Monday 1st June 2026

English	This week we will continue to plan and write our own version of The Egyptian Cinderella. The children will plan and write paragraph 6 and 7 using the success criteria to support them.
Maths	This week we will learn how to recognise and draw horizontal and vertical lines and to identify parallel and perpendicular lines in a range of different contexts. We will then learn to name 2D shapes and their properties which will then draw some 2D shapes. Finally, to recognise and name a variety of 3D shapes in different orientations.
Science	This week we will be learning about magnets. Firstly focusing on their north and south poles and how they attract and repel each other. We will then learn about contact and non-contact forces in a practical way.
Topic	This week we will learn about the Egyptian landscapes and fashion. In art, the children will finish off making and decorating their egyptian collar necklace.
