Year 4 learning:

Week beginning: Monday 1st June 2026

English	To build on their playscript learning, the children will learn how to write and use stage directions. The children will learn to identify what a stage direction is and what their role is in a playscript. They will learn how to write them before doing some drama work to test if they have written good ones.
Maths	In Maths this week the children will be learning about translations. The children will be learning about what a translation is and how it links into the work they have done on coordinates. The children will then be doing their own translations.
Science	Last week, the children designed an art project that needed to incorporate a circuit into it. This week, they are going to be building their circuit around the project to finalise and complete it.
Topic	In topic, the children will be learning about Greek artefacts. They will be looking at a variety of items used by the Greeks. The children will be learning about what they are, what they are used for and what they are made from. They will then compare these to modern artefacts that do a similar job.
