Year 5 Learning:

Week beginning: Monday 1st June 2026

Maths	This week, we will be adding five digit numbers with an exchange, looking at coordinates and then we will have two revision lessons before our hot task, which will be on Monday 8th May.
Writing	During writing lessons, the children will begin a shared write of a non-chronological report. Using the model Snow Leopard text as a base, they will begin adapting the structure to suit content about a different animal.
Integrated curriculum	In Topic, children will learn the main divisions of the Earth, including hemispheres, the equator, tropics, and poles, and identify the UAE's location on the Tropic of Cancer. They will also be introduced to concepts of Latitude, Longitude and Prime Meridian.
Science	As we continue our learning on life cycles, the children will be learning about the life cycle of a bird. Then they will have the opportunity to observe eggshells/incubated eggs – they will be discussing their development and how an incubator works.
