Year 6 learning:

Week beginning: Monday, 1st June 2026

Maths	This week in maths, the children will be focusing on converting measurements, as well as developing their understanding of currency and time. Pupils will be practising a range of skills including converting between units of measurement, solving money problems, and reading and calculating time accurately.
Writing	This week in English Writing, the children will be learning about the features of a legend story. We will also focus on using direct speech correctly, including punctuation, and expanding simple sentences to make writing more detailed and engaging.
IC	This week in IC, the children will begin creating a prototype of their own invention after learning about important inventions throughout history. Pupils will use the Design and Technology process to design, create, and evaluate their ideas.
Science	This week in Science, pupils will explore the importance of a healthy diet in Lesson 1 and the importance of exercise in Lesson 2. The children will take part in both theory and practical activities to help develop their understanding of healthy lifestyles.
