Dear Parents,



With the temperatures continuing to rise, please be reminded that your child will need to wear their hat to play outdoors with their friends. As it is important for the children to continue with their daily exercise, school staff will continue to encourage students to play in the natural or built shade environments around the school and provide alternative arrangements when the heat is excessive. Please continue to ensure your child comes to school each day with the appropriate **sunscreen applied**, a **hat** to play outdoors and a **water bottle**.



Important Information:

Year 2 learning:

Week beginning: **Monday 8th June 2026**

Maths	<p>In maths, we will carry on with our <i>Fractions</i> unit of work. To start the week, the children will begin to learn about non-unit fractions, which are fractions when the numerator is greater than 1. For example: $\frac{3}{2}$, $\frac{2}{4}$ and $\frac{3}{4}$. The children will then learn that $\frac{1}{2}$ and $\frac{2}{4}$ are equivalent fractions. Following this, they will start looking at $\frac{3}{4}$ of shapes before moving onto recognising and identifying $\frac{3}{4}$ of objects and then numbers. To calculate $\frac{3}{4}$ of a number, they will use the method of sharing, which is shown below:</p> 
English	<p>In English, the children will continue to learn to talk the 'Bob's Best Ever Friend' text. They will then begin to plan and write their own version of the story. We will continue to focus on getting the children to say their sentence, write their sentence and read their sentence back (to check that it makes sense). Within their writing, the children will be expected to include: capital letters, full stops, adjectives, exclamation marks and question marks as well as the conjunctions 'and', 'but' and 'so'.</p>
Science	<p>In science, we will be using our 'working scientifically' skills as the children are presented with the 'Humpty Dumpty Challenge'. Can they choose the appropriate materials and work together in their groups to protect Humpty Dumpty when he has his 'great fall'?</p>
Integrated Curriculum	<p>As part of our 'Up, Up and Away' topic, the children will work together to make an aeroplane, including the logo, before testing how well their creation flies against the other groups.</p>
