Dear Parents,



With the temperatures continuing to rise, please be reminded that your child will need to wear their hat to play outdoors with their friends. ## Year 4 learning:

**Week beginning: Monday 8th June 2026**

English	The children have finished looking at all the features of a playscript. Therefore, we are moving onto the next stage of our process which is to plan their own playscript. They will be creating a new setting and characters whilst sticking closely to the text of "Goldilocks and the three bears".
Maths	The children are going to be consolidating the work they have done earlier in the year on fractions. They will be learning about converting fractions into decimals, specifically looking at tenths and hundredths. Following this, we will explore comparing and ordering these different types of fractions and decimals.
Science	With the class teacher, the children have just completed their practical experiment of the water cycle. Throughout the week, the children will check on their experiment to see the results. In the lesson this week, the children will complete a write up on what the final results were. In their specialist lesson, the children will be finishing off their circuit designs and implementing the electrical materials.
Topic	Expanding on our learning of Ancient Greece, children learn about Ancient Greece and how the first Olympic Games began to honour Zeus, with only male athletes and a few events. They then compare this to today's Olympics, where men and women from all over the world compete in many sports and win medals, showing how traditions have changed over time.
