Dear Parents,

With the temperatures continuing to rise, please be reminded that your child will need to wear their hat to play outdoors with their friends. ## Year 5 learning:

### Week beginning: Monday 8th June 2026

Maths	In maths, on Monday we will have an assessment, topics include- addition and subtraction, cube numbers, decimal numbers, coordinates, translation and reflection. During the rest of the week, we will cover addition word problems, short division and subtraction with 5-digits.
Writing	In writing, the children will conduct research on a topic which will be used to plan and write a non-chronological report.
Integrated curriculum	In Topic next week, children will learn about migration and explore why animals move from one habitat to another. They will look at examples of migratory animals and the routes they travel.
Science	In science, the children will be learning about complete and incomplete metamorphosis. They will then be using a venn diagram to compare the life cycle of a mammal compared to a bird.
