FS2 Learning:

Week beginning: Monday 15th June 2026

This week in EAD we are going to continue with junk modelling where we use all of the skills we have learnt this year to create something new.

This week in Literacy, we will continue using picture prompts to inspire our writing. The children will carefully observe images, discuss what they can see, and use their ideas to write simple sentences. We will encourage the use of finger spaces, capital letters and full stops to help develop confidence and independence in writing.

In Understand the World this week, we will continue to explore and learn about different life cycles. We will be focusing on the life cycle of a chicken and recapping the life cycle of a frog, comparing the similarities and differences between them.

This week in Mathematics, we will continue revisiting and consolidating the concepts we have learned throughout the year.

This week in Phonics, we will continue revising previously taught sounds while focusing on teaching and practicing the reading and spelling of words having previously learned digraphs. Children will also practice recognising and recalling taught graphemes, alongside reading, and writing sentences independently.
