Year 1 learning:

Week beginning: Monday 15th June 2026

This week, in maths we will revisit our addition and subtraction topic and work with numbers up to 100. Throughout the week we will recap our knowledge on subtraction and answer sums using a range of strategies. We will then use this to subtraction from and across 10.

During our English lessons, we will continue our text 'Journey'. We will start the week by making predictions about what will happen next based on previous events and pictures. Finally we will learn about speech bubbles and when they are used, then we will complete our own.

In our Phonic lessons we will be revisiting our sounds soft 'g' (as in giraffe), 'soft c' (as in race), 'o' (as in go) and 'e' (as in he). We will use our knowledge to read and spell words containing these sounds as well as forming them correctly. We will practice reading real words and pseudo alien words.

In Science we will continue our investigations and we will make predictions and observations during our experiment when we watch what happens. We will complete a 'Colour changing flowers' experiment that looks at plant physiology and water absorption.
