## Year 4 learning:

**Week beginning: Monday 15th June 2026**

English	The children have been preparing to write their own playscripts and have come up with characters, a setting and have practiced how to write dialogiue. This week, they will plan the writing of their playscript before editing and writing it.
Maths	The children will continue to review the learning that they have done this term. The children will be learning about coordinates and how to plot and recognise their position. They will be learning about translations and how to move whole shapes, rather than just one point
Science	In Science, the children are starting a new experiment to test their working scientifically knowledge. They are going to build a boat out of tin foil to test who can build the strongest one whilst making it a fair test. They will then test the boat using marbles
Topic	Continuing to look at the Greek states, we will be exploring the different city states of Athens and Sparta. We will learn about their different methods towards life. Specifically, how they differ in education, army and how they live their daily life.
