Year 5 learning:

Week beginning: Monday 15th June 2026

Maths	In maths, we will begin a new short unit on statistics. Lessons include- tables, 2-way tables and timetables.
Writing	Now the children have conducted their research and planned their non-chronological report, they will have their final hot write and will be writing their own non-chronological report on a topic of their choice. They will need to include sub-headings, formal language, technical vocabulary, relative clauses, topic sentences, a title, an introduction, and write in the present tense.
Integrated curriculum	Next week In Topic, students will learn about whales. They will see that whales are visitors to the waters surrounding the UAE and explore different whale species while recording information about these remarkable marine mammals.
Science	Next week, the children will be learning about the plant life cycle and seed dispersal. Then, with Ms Taylor, they will be conducting an experiment where they dissect a flower and learn about all the different parts and functions.

Respect



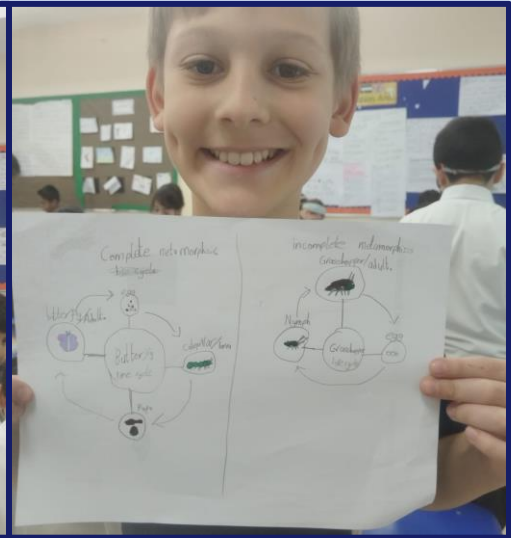
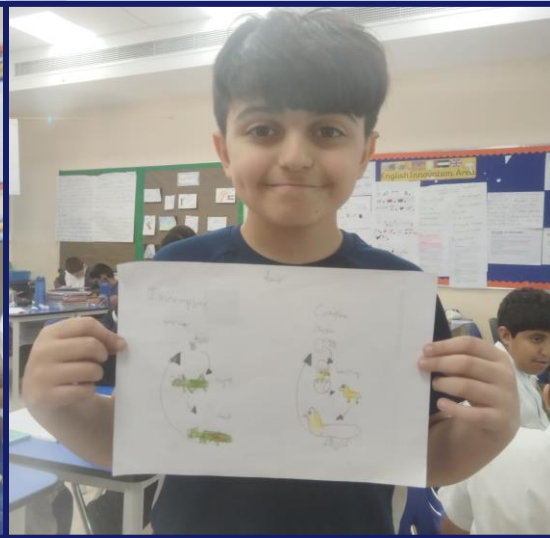
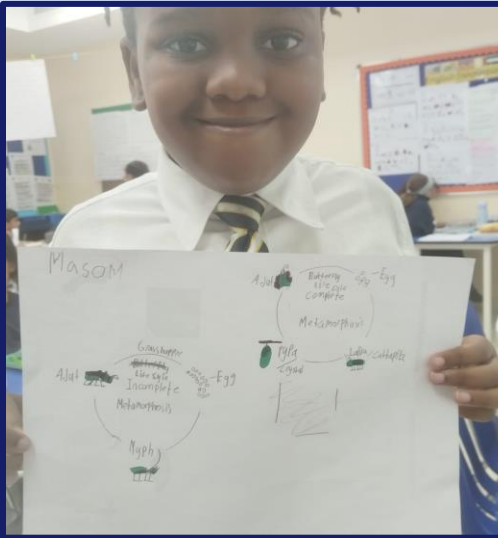
Inspired by the legacy of the founding father, Sheikh Zayed bin Sultan Al Nahyan we will focus on the value of **Respect** in Term 3.
