FS2 Learning:

Week beginning: Monday 22nd June 2026

This week in Understanding the World, we will continue to explore the life cycles of different living things. We will consolidate our learning about the life cycles of frogs and chickens. We will also be recapping the key learning content that we have covered throughout the year.

In literacy we will continue to develop our writing skills through a range of exciting activities and picture prompts. We will also continue to build confidence in reading, speaking and storytelling as we celebrate all the progress made throughout the year.

In maths, we continue revisiting concepts learned throughout the year focusing on number and numerical patterns in mathematics this week.

In EAD, we will continue to use our skills to create new things through junk modelling. The children will be encouraged to use their creativity to show off their skills.

This week in Phonics, we will continue revising previously taught sounds while focusing on teaching and practicing the reading and spelling of words having previously learned digraphs. Children will also practice recognising and recalling taught graphemes, alongside reading, and writing sentences independently.
