## Year 4 learning:

**Week beginning: Monday 22nd June 2026**

English	The children will be exploring different ways that they can use interesting vocabulary to include in creative writing. They will then be using their grammar skills to solve a variety of problems and puzzles.
Maths	The children will complete their hot task on Monday before going through the answers on Tuesday and reviewing the mistakes they made. The children will then spend the rest of the week using problem solving skills to solve a variety of problems.
Science	Last week, the children created boats out of tin foil to test how stable they could make them. We then tested this by placing marbles into the boats until they sank. The children analysed their designs and next week they will remake them to see if they can improve on their initial design.
Topic	Next Thursday, the children will be participating in our annual "Greek Day". During this day the children will participate in a numerous amount of activities based around the Ancient Greeks. The children are welcome to dress up in an Ancient Greek outfit.
