

AAESS PRIMARY SCHOOL DRESS CODE

General Appearance

AAESS believes that a clearly stated and sensibly implemented uniform policy is important. There is no question that the school's uniform instills a feeling of school spirit, sense of pride and social acceptance. It also prevents excesses in fashion trends and eliminates competition among students, often based on parents' ability to provide suitable clothes. The school will continue to strictly implement the proper uniform as it helps foster the values and environment we endeavor to create.

Role of Parents

We ask that all parents support the school dress code. We believe that parents have a duty to send their children to school appropriately dressed and ready for learning every day. If a child arrives wearing clothing or accessories that do not meet the school's uniform expectations, parents will be notified and may be asked to ensure that the issue is addressed promptly.

FS1 (Nursery) – Year 2



Girls

- **AAESS shirt** - short sleeve.
- **AAESS Skort** - knee length.
- **AAESS dress**
- **AAESS Jacket** - optional. Only the AAESS fleece jacket may be worn with the uniform.
- **Black Shoes** - No sandals, boots, high heels, flip flops, hybrid trainers of any kind.
- **Socks** - navy blue ankle socks only
- **Tights** - navy blue. Only to be worn in the winter months.
- **Hair** - should be neat, clean and of a natural colour. No extremes are permitted. Long hair must be tied back for reasons of health, safety and hygiene. Hairbands must be plain and black or navy. No wide headbands, hair decoration or bandanas.
- **Jewellery** - one pair of plain studs (worn in the lobe of the ear).
- **School Bags** - Students must come to school with an appropriate sized bag that can be hung on a peg.
- **Hats** - AAESS baseball caps are available for students for use outside. These must always be worn by the students when they are outside the school building. AAESS Primary School has a strict No Hat, No Play Policy.

Boys

- **AAESS shirt** - short sleeve.
- **AAESS Shorts** - knee length.
- **AAESS trousers** - only to be worn in the winter months.
- **AAESS Jacket** (optional) - Only the AAESS fleece jacket may be worn with the uniform.
- **Black Shoes** - No sandals, boots, flip flops, hybrid trainers of any kind.
- **Socks** - navy blue ankle socks only.
- **Hair** - should be neat, clean and of a natural colour. No extremes are permitted
- **School Bags** - Students must come to school with an appropriate sized bag that can be hung on a peg.
- **Hats** - AAESS baseball caps are available for students for use outside. These must always be worn by the students when they are outside the school building. AAESS Primary School has a strict No Hat, No Play Policy.

Year 3 – Year 6

Girls



- **AAESS shirt** – short or long sleeve.
(Long sleeve shirt must be worn with long skirt or girls trousers ONLY)
- **AAESS skirt** – knee length or long skirt
- **AAESS Girls Trousers**
- **AAESS Jacket** (optional) - Only the AAESS jacket may be worn with the uniform.
- **Black Shoes** - NO sandals, boots, flip flops, hybrid trainers of any kind.
- **Socks** - navy blue ankle socks
- **Hair** - should be neat, clean and of a natural colour. No extremes are permitted. Long hair must be tied back for reasons of health, safety and hygiene. Hairbands must be plain and back or navy. No wide headbands, hair decoration or bandanas.
- **Jewellery** - one pair of plain studs (worn in the lobe of the ear).
- **School Bags** - must be clearly labeled. Students must come to school with an appropriate sized bag that can be stored in a small locker or hung on a peg. It needs to be designed to comfortably hold A4 size workbooks without them being damaged.
- **Hats** – AAESS baseball caps are available for students for use outside. No other cap is acceptable. These must always be worn by the students when they are outside the school building. AAESS Primary School has a strict No Hat, No Play Policy

BOYS



- **AAESS shirt** – short or long sleeve.
(Long sleeve shirt must be worn with long trousers ONLY)
- **AAESS shorts or long trousers**
- **AAESS Jacket** – (optional). Only the AAESS fleece jacket may be worn with the uniform.
- **Black Shoes** – NO sandals, boots, flip flops, hybrid trainers of any kind.
- **Socks** – navy blue ankle socks only
- **Hair** – should be neat, clean and of a natural colour. No extremes are permitted.
- **Jewellery** – no jewellery.
- **School Bags** – must be clearly labeled. Students must come to school with an appropriate sized bag that can be stored in a small locker or hung on a peg. It needs to be designed to comfortably hold A4 size workbooks without them being damaged.
- **Hats** – AAESS baseball caps are available for students for use outside. No other cap is acceptable. These must always be worn by the students when they are outside the school building. AAESS Primary School has a strict No Hat, No Play Policy.
- **Under shirt** – a plain white under shirt may be worn under the School shirt. Only a short sleeve under shirt may be worn under an AAESS short sleeve shirt. No designs or football shirts.

Parental Responsibility

- All AAESS clothing items are only available from the Uniform Shop at School.
- As part of student's sun protection plan, parents are encouraged to provide sun protection cream for their children.
- Parents are asked to ensure that all items belonging to their child are CLEARLY MARKED with their names.
- Students must observe and be aware of the consequences of violating local customs.

The School's Senior Management Team will be the final arbitrator in matters relating to the uniform.

It is expected that all students will be wearing correct uniform by the start of the third week of the first term. After this date, parents of uniform offenders will be notified to ensure that the matter is addressed promptly, and the proper uniform attire is worn.

All members of the school staff are conscious of their role in implementing this dress code by setting an example in their own neatness and appropriateness of dress and by ensuring that children are neatly attired when participating in any school activity.
