Drop-off and pick-up reminders

Please remember that punctuality is important.

Registration takes place between **7:30am and 7:40am**. The national anthem plays at **7:30am**, and the first main lesson starts promptly at **7:40am**.



For pick-up, the gates open at **2:30pm or 3:20pm** and remain open for **20 minutes**. For late pick-ups after this time, parents must use the main gate to collect their child.

Extra-Curricular Activities

Extra-Curricular Activities (ECAs) start this week. Children who signed up will be taken to their chosen activity between **2:30pm and 3:20pm**.

ADEK collection policy

In line with ADEK policy, children under 15 should arrive at and leave school with their designated adults. Siblings over 15 years of age may pick up younger brothers and sisters from Y1–Y6 with signed, pre-agreed permission. Only adults over 18 may pick up children from FS2 and Preschool.

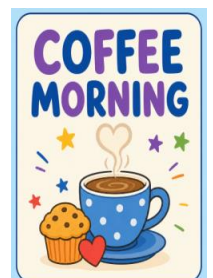
Book Fair

Year 2 Learning this week

Week beginning: Monday 14th September 2026

English	In English, we will begin a new unit linked to our 'Healthy Me' topic. We will start by exploring the text 'Avocado Baby'. The children will listen to and discuss the story, sharing their opinions and what they like or dislike about it. Following this, they will be introduced to a new text map: an instructional text titled 'How to Make an Avocado Smoothie'. They will begin by learning to 'talk the text' before focusing on reading and understanding some of the more challenging vocabulary. We will then move on to exploring verbs.
Maths	In maths, the children will be learning about 'Place Value'. They will begin the week by practising how to count back from a given 2-digit number. They will use a 100 square to support with this skill. Next, the children will learn how to find one more and one less than a given number (between 1-100) before moving onto learning how to recognise the place value of each digit in a 2-digit number (tens and ones).
Science	In science, the children will be testing the effects of exercise on the human body.
Integrated Curriculum	To launch our new 'Healthy Me' topic, the children will be doing some fruit tasting. Please inform your child's class teacher if your child is allergic to any fruit.
