English	In English this week we will start with our suspense story. We will gather information on prior knowledge, read and retell the story and apply actions and suspense techniques.
Maths	This week in maths, we will be collecting data from our class and the year group. We will explore different ways of representing the information using an array of charts to identify the best presentation.

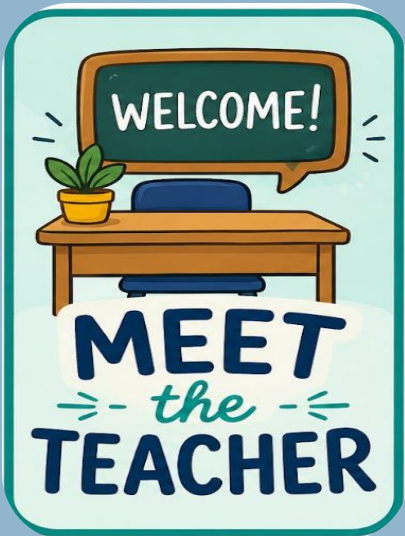

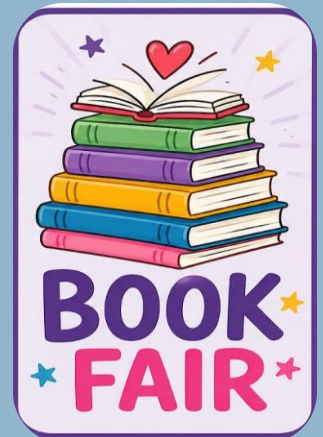
